- There were 813.5 FTE accredited intern positions filled in Victoria in 2016 for 2017 commencement; this was an increase of five positions from 2015/16.

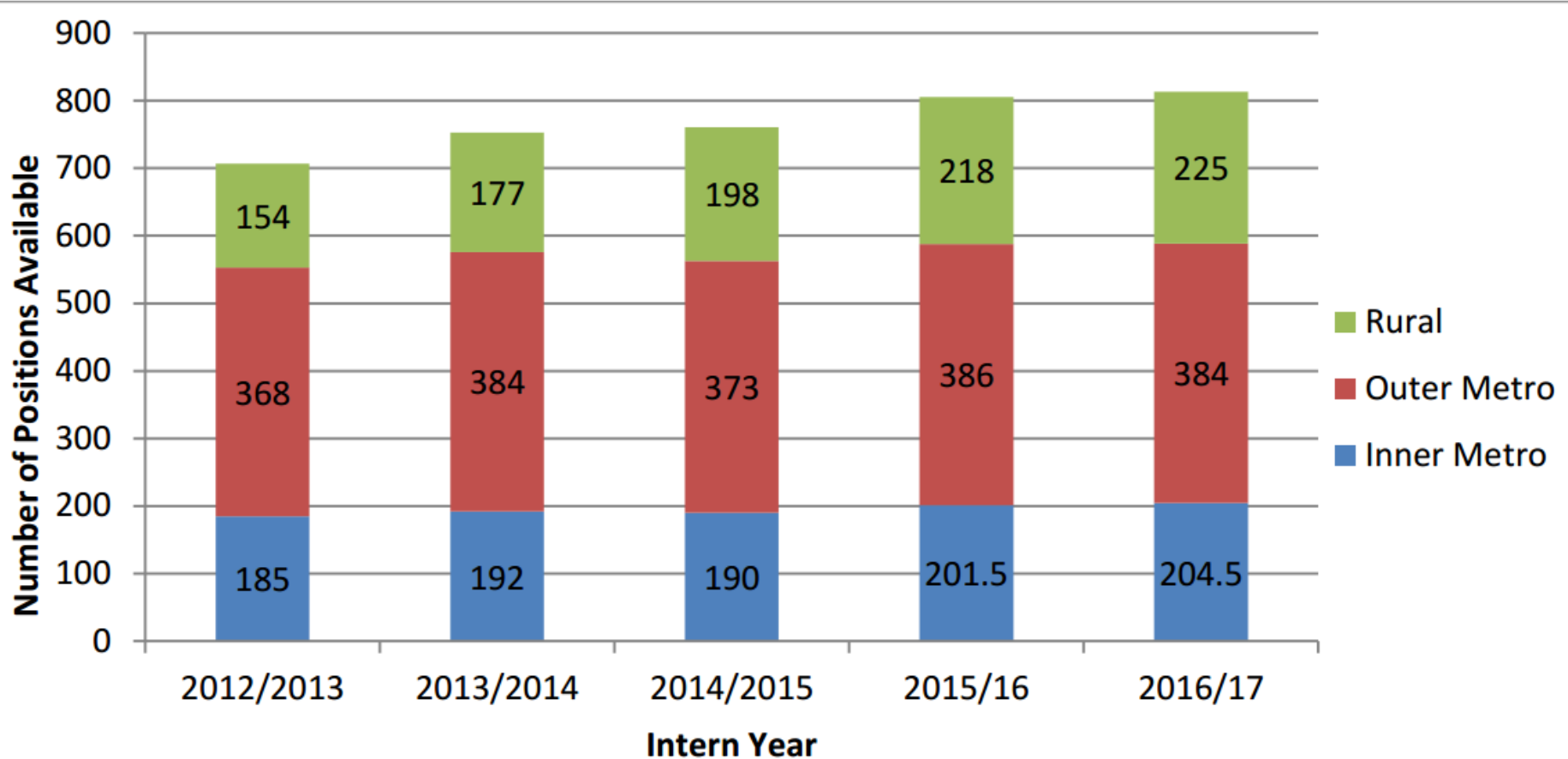

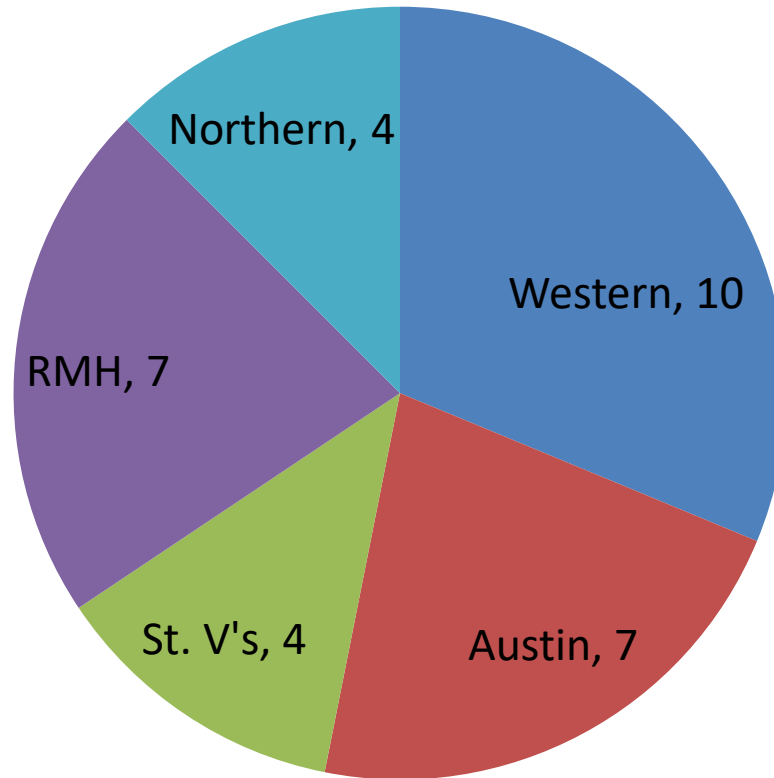

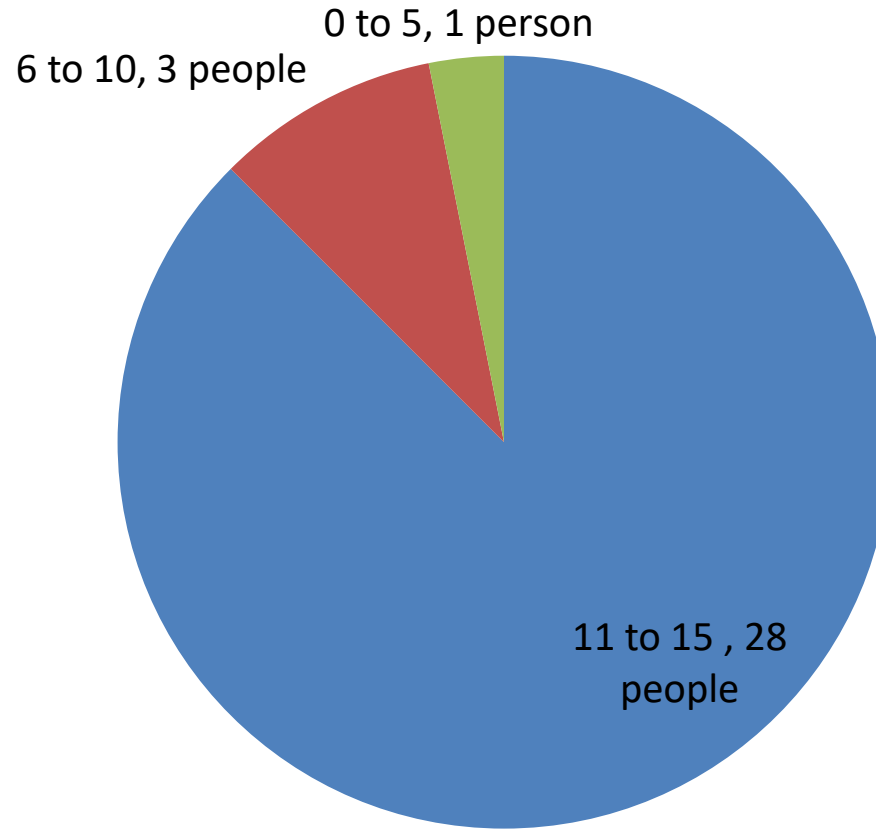

Number of International MD4s who responded to our survey



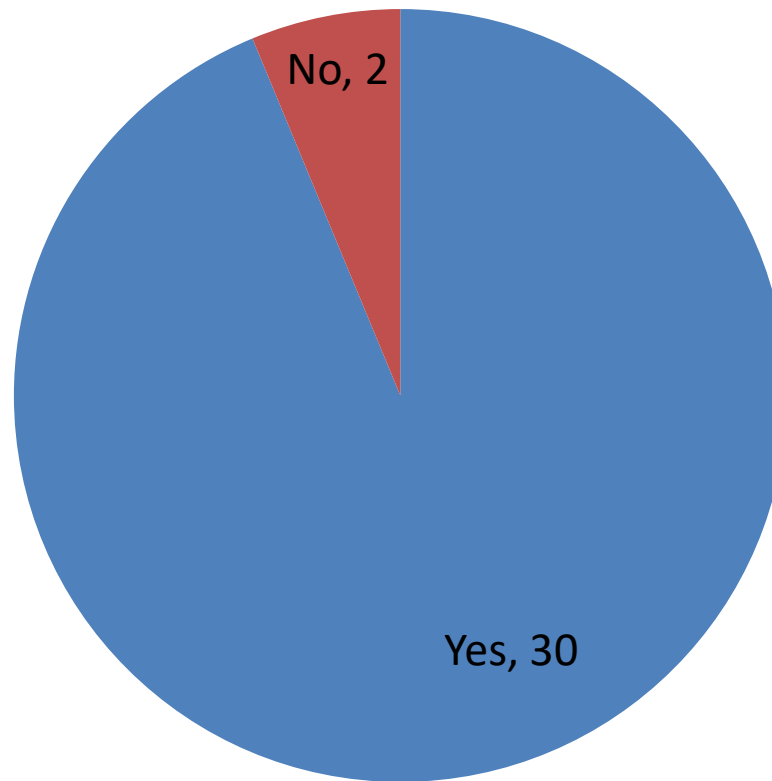

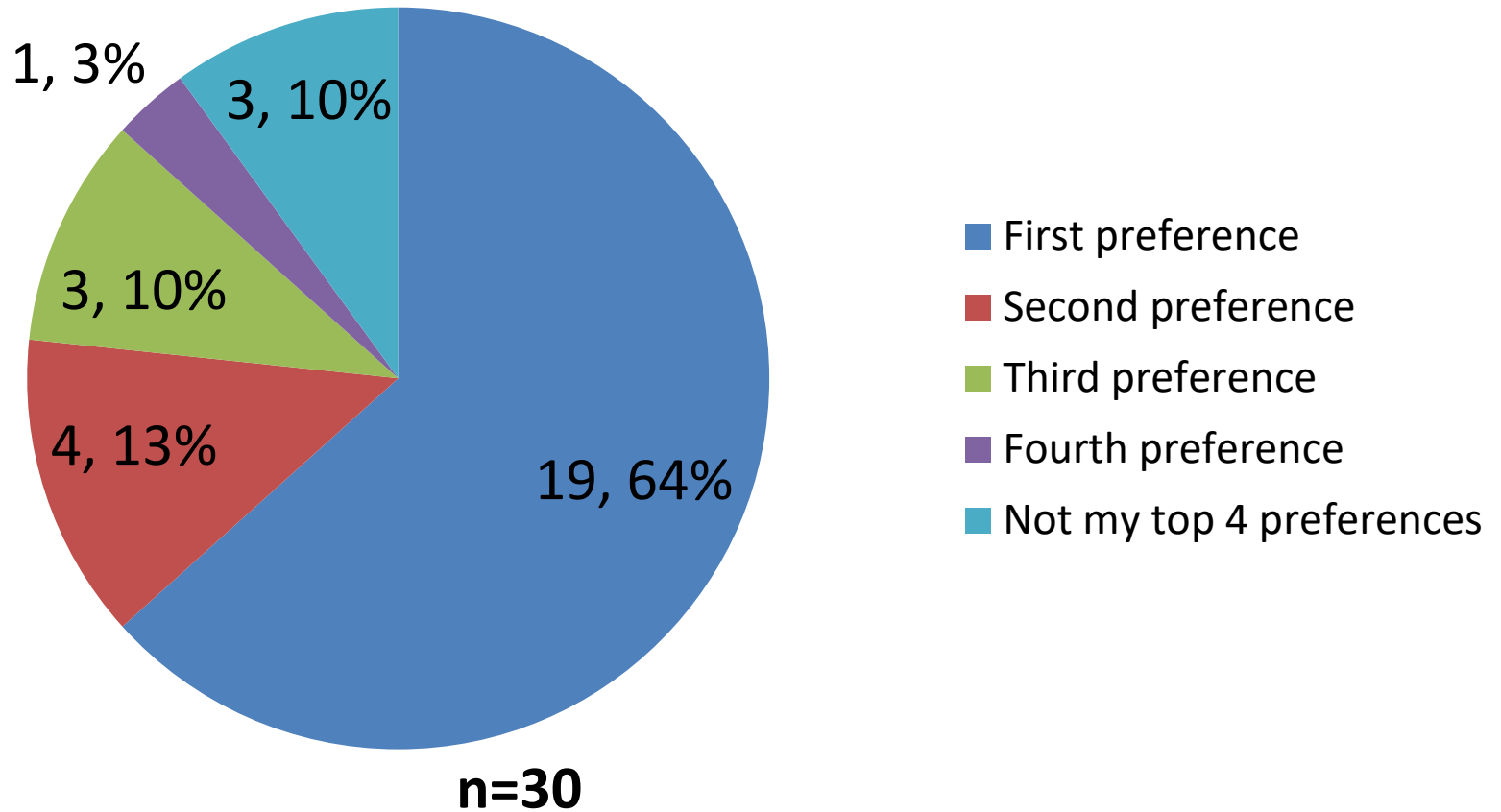
Did you get matched during Round 2 (for Priority Group 2/International students)?

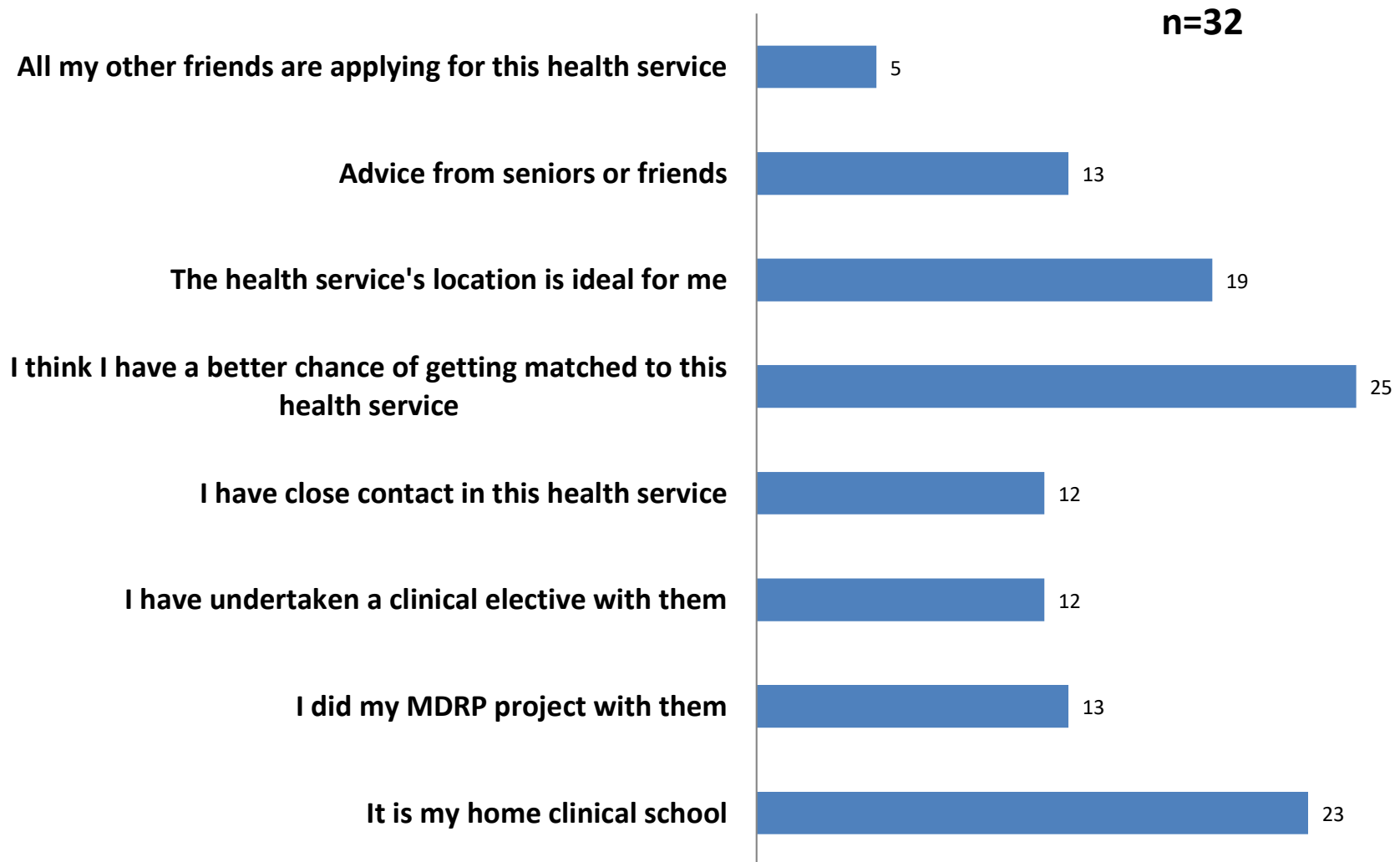

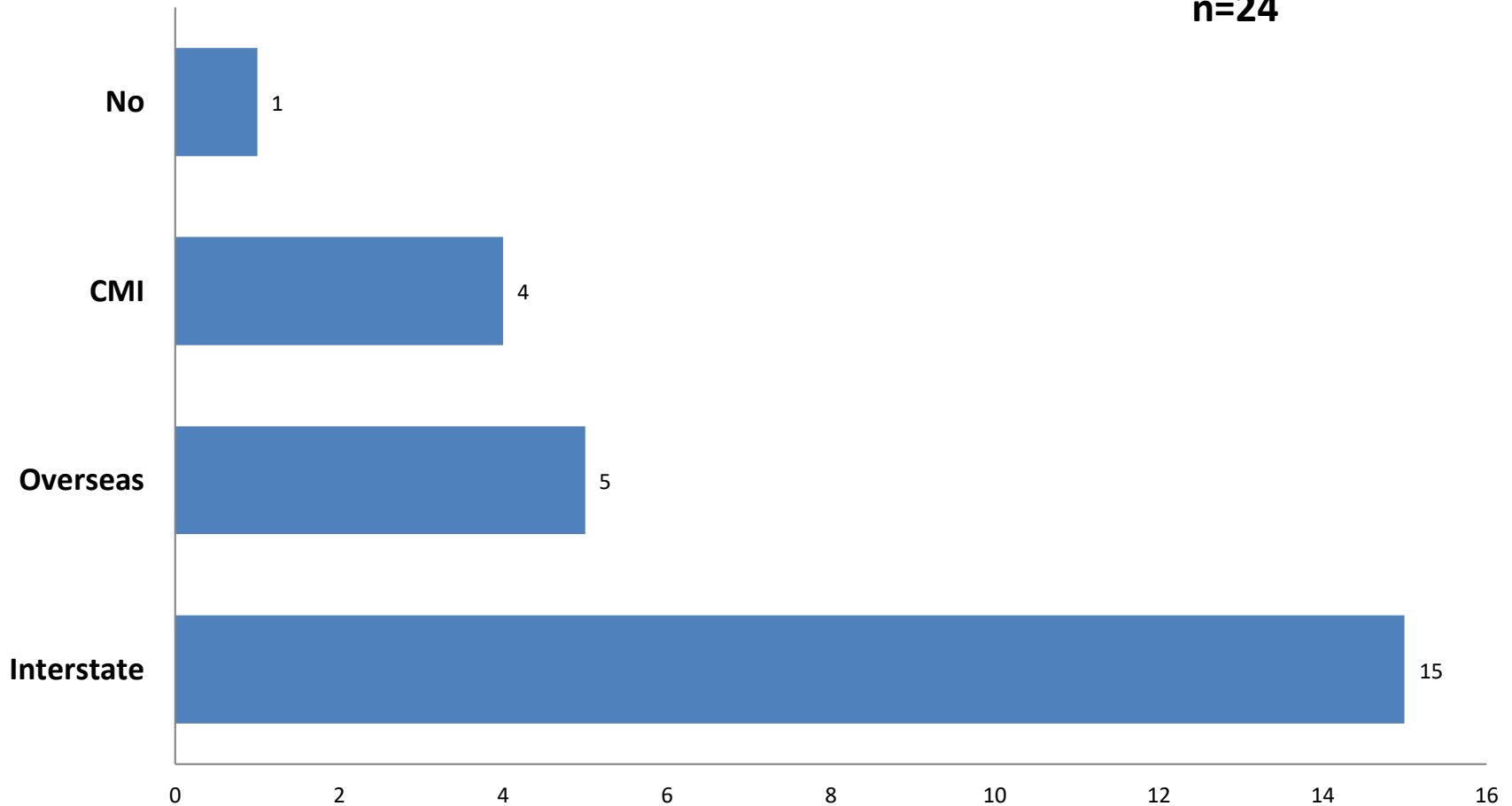

What would influence your decision to apply for a particular health service?



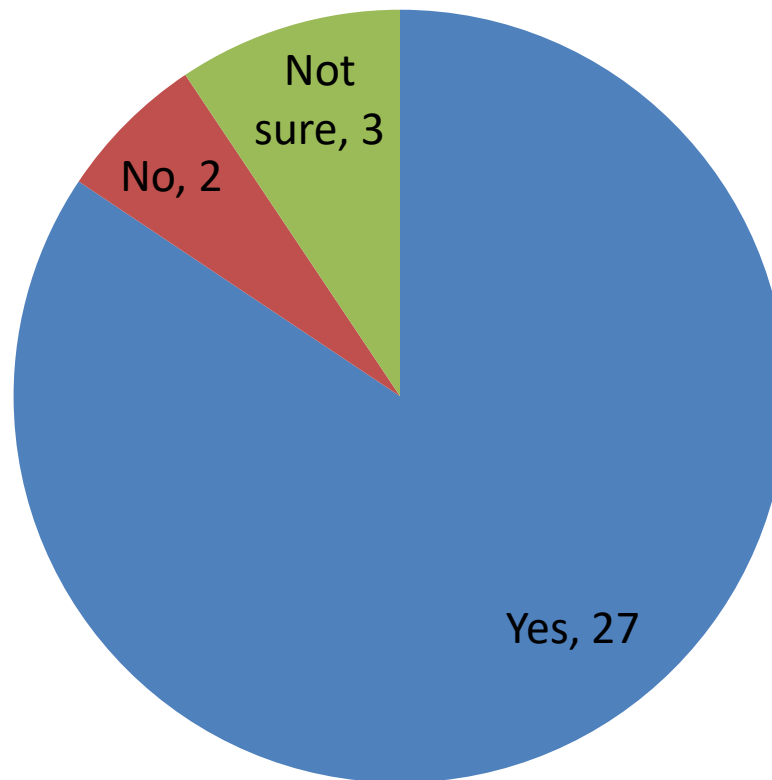
Did you have any "back-up" plans apart from applying to Victorian health services?
