- The total number of internship positions in Victoria for 2018 commencement is predicted to be 807 (details on next slide).








Number of International MD4s who responded to our survey



What is the total number of Victorian health services you have applied for?




Did you get matched during Round 2 (for Priority Group 2/International students)?






What would influence your decision to apply for a particular health service?
