   Preferential Recruitment (involves interviews and preferencing), Direct
   Regional Allocation, Optimised Allocation

# **SOUTH AUSTRALIA**

- Need to upload a range of documentation (a copy of your passport, a copy of visa, academic transcript, CV etc)
- In 2015, SA could not guarantee all p1 graduates internship spot (i.e. p1 graduates > internship spots)
- EPAS training (online modules for electronic medical record system) required prior to application

- Check step-by-step user manual on each website
- English language results (AHPRA)
  - https://www.ahpra.gov.au/registration/registration-standards/english-language-skills.aspx
- Effort & time spent doing the applications
  - Victoria = the most time consuming application
  - ACT and WA = next time consuming application with extensive "selection criteria" responses
  - SA = requires EPAS online module training
  - QLD = requires some written response; why QLD, which hospitals
  - NSW = ballot based. Least time consuming.
- Start early and apply broadly. It's all about time management!
